No winter shoes/boots.

### Donate over the counter medicines and health related items that are needed include:

- ibuprophen (advil, generics are fine)
- acetaminophen (tylenol, generics are fine)
- aspirin
- children and infant versions of all of the above pain relievers
- multi-vitamins for kids and adults (no gummies, they melt)
- tums
- allergy meds — zyrtec or equivalent
- lotrimin
- skin lotions
- toothbrushes and paste
- cheater eyeglasses
